- *will undertake all reasonable care to ensure safety and security at all times*
- *will provide termly meetings with teaching staff and an annual written report at the end of the year. Appointments can be made with either class teachers or the Head Teacher.*
- *will let parents know about any concerns that may affect their child's learning or behaviour*
- *will keep parents informed about school activities through regular letters home, topic sheets and notices about special events*
- *will aim to handle sensitively any concern or complaint and respond either through the class teacher or Head Teacher in order to resolve any difficulties quickly*

I will try to:

- *support the school's Mission Statement, ethos and rules as outlined in my school brochure.*
- *ensure that my child goes to bed at a reasonable time before a school day and will send him/her to school in reasonable health*
- *Support the Healthy Schools Policy.*
- *ensure that my child attends school daily and on time – 9.00/8.55a.m and collect him/her at 3.00/3.15p.m.*
- *inform the school of a named adult who will collect my child from school, and in the event of any change to this arrangement will notify the school beforehand either by telephone or letter*

- *hear my child read each evening and encourage him/her to complete any homework set, by assisting him/her and giving him/her time in a quiet environment, to aid his/her learning.*

- *I have read and understood the school's discipline and anti-bullying policy in my school brochure and agree to give the school my total support.*
