Date	Subject	Test Paper
Monday 14 th May	English: Grammar Punctuation and Spelling	2 papers: spelling; punctuation and grammar (including vocabulary)
Tuesday 15 th May	English: Reading	1 paper
Wednesday 16 th May	Mathematics	2 papers: arithmetic; mathematical reasoning
Thursday 17 th May	Mathematics	1 paper: mathematical reasoning

Some useful tips:

- Children need to come to school having eaten and drunk something for breakfast.
