We welcome back all our families and extend a special welcome to those new to the school.

There has been a substantial amount of work completed within the school over the summer break; the junior corridors have been repainted and the Reception toilets completely refurbished. In addition to this the local authority have organised roofing work to the buildings; the infant section was completed over the summer break but we are expecting the scaffolding for the junior building work to remain until half term.

Macmillan Coffee Morning

Year 6 will be running a coffee morning on **Friday 26th September** in aid of Macmillan Cancer Support. The coffee morning will be held in the infant hall from 9.00 to 10.15. All are welcome and we hope that as many of you as possible will come and join them to raise money for this worthwhile cause.

New Primary Curriculum

Over the past year we have been planning for the introduction of the new primary curriculum which is a requirement from this September. Following many planning sessions and discussions with the children we will be adopting a theme based curriculum which will incorporate science, history, geography, art, design technology and music. The curriculum overview will be available this week on the school website under the Parent Information section, additional information for each year group will also be available under Classroom Information in the next couple of weeks. Although there will be some cross over into English and mathematics these subjects, along with computing will be taught separately, information about the mathematics curriculum can also be found on the website. We will continue to follow the current school PE curriculum and the Croydon RE syllabus.

Details of our Special Educational Needs (SEN) offer and a link to the Local Authority information will also be available on the website.

Free School Meals – Pupil Premium

As you will be aware from the national press all children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are now entitled to free school dinners. You do not need to register for this either with the school or on Parent Pay; the children should just indicate during registration whether they require a dinner or have brought packed lunch.

Children of parents and carers who receive the following:

- Income support
- Income based jobs seeker's allowance
- o Income related employment and support allowance
- o Guaranteed state pension credit
- Child tax credit
- o Financial support by National Asylum Support Service

also attract Pupil Premium funding which is given to the school to enhance the learning for these children. If you fall into any of these categories please speak to the school office and fill in a 'Free School Meals Application' form <u>even if your child is in the infants</u>. All children who are named on the school pupil premium list will be entitled to one free school uniform every year (sweatshirt, T Shirt, PE Kit) and on entry to the school a book bag, PE bag, water bottle and school baseball hat; these items will be funded through pupil premium payments. Should your child be in receipt of Pupil Premium (i.e. have been on the free school meals list in the past six years) and you wish to take up the offer of a set of uniform please speak to the school office.

School dinner charges remain in place for the junior children and all Parent Pay dinner accounts must remain in credit.

Julie Maudsley Award

It is now a year since the sudden death of Mrs Maudsley, a much valued and sorely missed member of the staff at Keston for many years. We have taken the decision to make a special award in her name for up to two children each year. Instrument Tuition

Children in year 5 and 6 are able to continue or commence learning a wind musical instrument through Croydon Music and Arts who offer group and paired lessons based in the school; these lessons must be booked and paid for directly with the music service through their website; www.croydonmusicandarts.co.uk.

In addition we have been able to organise tuition for guitar, ukulele, keyboard, flute and voice through Carol Whinnom who, prior to last year, taught guitar groups and ukulele to our year 4s very successfully; she will also be undertaking the whole class ukulele tuition for a year 4 class from next term. We have keyboards in school and a few ukuleles which will be available on loan, however children will require their own guitars or flutes and ideally access to keyboards at home for practise. If your child is just beginning to learn the flute Mrs Whinnom would suggest learning initially on a fife which can be purchased at a cost of about $\pounds 10$.

These lessons, which will take place during school time, are available to all junior children at the rates listed below:
