The more colourful, the better!

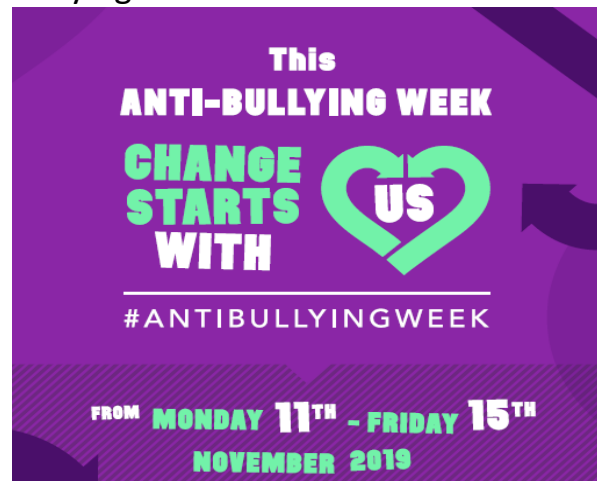

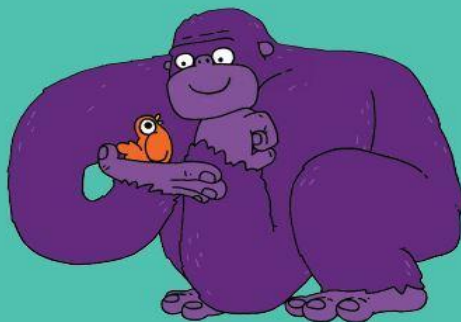
