We have written a new suggested time table for the next two weeks, please see below for specific expectations:

English:

Their comprehension book should now be completed, so we will upload a weekly comprehension onto the website.

Spellings will continue as per normal, and we still expect the children to be reading at least 3 x per week.

Maths:

Please encourage your child to maintain their times tables skills; even if they are secure in all of their times tables, they still require attention in order to keep them in a good place. The Summer Term is when we would have been teaching the topic of time. We will not be setting any work based on this topic, however, it would be beneficial if you could continue incorporating this into your daily schedule e.g. "Come and help me set the table at 6.30pm, what will the hands look like on the clock when it gets to that time?"

Challenge:

On occasion, we will be offering the children the option of a challenge with their work. Below is a key that you can use to help identify the level of challenge, however the children are used to this and are good at choosing the appropriate challenge for themselves.

Key:

Fantastic: "I would like to ease into this."

Amazing: "I feel confident I can do this by myself."

Brilliant: "I am feeling super confident with this, and want some extra challenge."

Busy Things:

We will continue to set assignments on a Tuesday and Thursday.
