

## Maths Instructions

**Times Tables Rock Stars:** This is a new programme that we are learning to use at the moment. Please can I advise that the games that are labelled **Garage** and **Arena** include the times tables that we have set them and that are for the appropriate levels. The other games include all times tables.

Please see below a Maths time table for the week for you to follow:

**All worksheets are labelled with the corresponding day,**

**Monday – Complete page 2-Measuring up. Extension: Challenge cards. There is also a PowerPoint to use as a starter or at the end of the lesson.**

**Tuesday –Complete page 5- Turn up the heat. Extension: Can the children make up their own questions about the thermometers, for example what is the difference in temperature between e and f.**

**Wednesday – Complete page 6- comparing capacities and 7- zoo weighing. There is a more challenging extension sheet also on the website. Another extension could be to find objects around the house and order them from lightest to heaviest or compare bottles of liquids from most full to least full.**

**Thursday –Complete the arithmetic test.**

**Friday – Complete at least one of the maths activity mats.**

**Please be aware all work is differentiated for your child’s level please decide which work is appropriate.**

**Please check the investigation and more challenging reasoning sheet. Please check it is appropriate for your child’s ability.**

We have attached an arithmetic and reasoning test, these can be completed in addition to the daily maths tasks that they should be completing.

Please can we remind you that our expectations are for at least one piece of maths work to be completed each day. We have uploaded a variety of activities if the children need extra work.

If you do not have a printer, the children can use the worksheets off a tablet/phone/computer and write the answers in their red exercise book.
