


Year 1 - A guide to this week's learning and links - week 4

Maths

- Please continue with all the counting. It will really help your child's maths. (Counting to beyond 100 forwards and backwards; counting in 2s, 5s and 10s; finding 1 more and 1 less than a given number.)
- We are continuing with: multiplication and division. This week we will work on arrays and end the week with doubling. (An array is a pictorial representation of a multiplication fact.)



2 x 3 or 3 x 2

- We have labelled the work Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday so you know the order in which the work needs to be done. There is a powerpoint which will explain some more about multiplication. There is extra work too if your child needs it. If the work is more difficult we have put challenge in the title.

- Daily reading - Children to continue daily reading. Please record this in their reading records as per normal. Please encourage them to read any books that you may have at home.
- Phonics: any online activity that practises phase 3, 4 and 5 sounds. Children are working on Phase 5 sounds at the moment. However, PhonicsPlay is free to use at the moment. There is no need to subscribe.

Focus this week on reading and spelling split digraph i-e (for example: like, pine, ripe, hide, nice, mice, prize, inside, slide, smile)
- The children can continue to practise the Year 1 Common Exception Words – these are in week 3 on the website.
- In their writing books can they write a diary for this week. Just 2 or 3 sentences for each day about what they have done. Remind them to use a capital letter at the beginning of their sentence and a full stop at the end. They can use words like: first, then, next, after that, finally.
- There is a reading comprehension in the folder. Please do the questions your child is most able to access.
- **An exciting resource we have just found is talk for writing. There is a great story with activities and questions based around it. It is called Sidney Spider – A Tale of Friendship.**
