Please aim to complete each of the 7 activities across the week. Support the children with recording their work as much as possible (this includes photos)!

*When the children are writing, please support them with sounding out but do not give them correct spellings. This will encourage them to make phonetically plausible attempts at spelling new words.

Continue joining in with the free daily phonics lessons on Youtube and try to read every day (either a scheme book on Oxford Owls or a picture book from home).
