


Even though Jesus is their Lord and Teacher, he treats them as an equal.

- ▶ Why is it important to treat others as an equal?
- ▶ Look up the word 'equality' in the dictionary.
- ▶ What does it mean?
- ▶ On a piece of paper, write the word 'equality' in a bubble, and mind map what that word means to you. Focus on:
 - ▶ Examples where equality is not present; how does that make people feel? Is it fair?
 - ▶ Examples where equality is present; in what ways is it different to when people aren't treated as equal.
 - ▶ Any words that you associate with equality, for example; fairness, right, equal opportunities.

Your task this week...

- ▶ You are going to create a collage, representing equality.
- ▶ First, plan your design by sketching out some ideas.
- ▶ The most important part is your outline - what shape do you want to have e.g. a head, a tower, a butterfly.
- ▶ If you want to have a background, we suggest collaging old newspaper, which will be black and white, and then you can use magazines to create a powerful main image.
- ▶ Find powerful words within your magazines or newspapers and place them in strategic points on your design!

How to do it...

- ▶ Cut up your paper/magazines into a variety of different sizes; tearing gives a nice effect.
- ▶ Practice laying out your cuttings BEFORE sticking.
- ▶ Paint a thin layer of PVA Glue onto the precise area you want to stick a cutting.
- ▶ Place that cutting directly on top of the glue.
- ▶ Seal the cutting in place by painting another thin layer of glue over the top of it.
- ▶ Ensure the edges are laying flat before repeating the process with another cutting.
