




Embedded Clauses

An embedded clause gives you more information in the middle of the sentence. If it were to be removed, the sentence would still make sense on its own.

The witch, **who has green eyes**, is very spooky.



My bike, **which is very old**, is broken.



Paragraph example

It could be said that the two characters of the Highwayman and Tim the Ostler are similar as they are both in love with Bess, the landlord's daughter. However, Tim's love for Bess is not reciprocated and this turns him into a jealous and spiteful person. When Tim hears the highwayman revealing the details of his return to the inn, he immediately seizes the opportunity to get revenge on the highwayman by alerting the King's guards. In contrast, the highwayman's relationship with Bess actually shows us a softer and more caring side to his personality.

Lesson 4

Passive Voice: When the action is performed upon the sentence's subject



If you can insert "by zombies" after the verb, passive voice is being used.

Example:

Passive Voice: She was chased [by zombies].

Active Voice: Zombies chased [by zombies] her.

Identifying Passive Voice

With Zombies!

Active Voice: When a sentence's subject performs the action
