Reception Red and Blue Classes

Phonics/Reading Weekly Tasks - 1 per day

The following activities use the interactive Bug Club Phonics resources. [Login](#) on any device and complete the online lessons assigned to you by your teacher. If you have some, use magnetic letters to complete the tasks. Alternatively, you can use pencil and paper.

- 1) Complete the 'Unit 6 Phoneme /j/ Lesson'.
- 2) Complete the 'Unit 6 Phoneme /v/ Lesson'.
- 3) Complete the 'Unit 6 Phoneme /w/ Lesson'.
- 4) Complete the 'Unit 6 Language Irregular' and 'Unit 6 Language Lesson'.

Additional activity - Read the book that has been assigned to you for this week.

Maths Weekly Task - 1 per day

These activities are based around the Oak Academy online learning scheme. In this unit, we will be learning all about the number 6.

- 1) Playing tea parties gives context in [this](#) lesson as we learn to count accurately to six.
- 2) In [this](#) lesson, we encounter subitising and make our own representations of the number six.
- 3) [This](#) lesson highlights that as we count in ones, the next number we say is one more than the previous one.
- 4) [This](#) lesson develops an understanding of one less/fewer in a familiar format.

Additional lesson - [This](#) lesson focuses on ordering numbers one to six. Complete the independent activities in the video.

Fine Motor/ Mark Making Tasks - 3+ per week

- 1) Use your funky fingers to cut out pictures from a magazine and label them. Alternatively, draw some different lines and shapes and practise cutting them out.

- 3) Have any bubble wrap from Christmas? Write some letters on the bubbles and pop away!
- 4) Grab some playdough, follow [this](#) link and join in with the dough gym song!
- 5) Draw or print a picture of your favourite character and write a speech bubble for them. What would they be saying?
