As we complete this very busy school term, I want to take this opportunity to thank all the children and families at Keston who have welcomed and supported me in my new role as Head of School.

I would also like to say a massive thank you to all the Keston families for your generosity regarding the good causes we support. The children have lots of suggestions for fund raising however I appreciate that it is the parents who financially support these ideas.

In the last half term, the school has supported:

Poppy Appeal: A total of £327.58 was raised (an increase of £82 from last year).

School Council Present Collection: This initiative, run by the School Council, produced another great response – the toys were donated to the Purley Food Hub for distribution to local families. They were very grateful for all of your donations.



Tadworth Children's Trust: Our Christmas collection resulted in a total donation of £687.66 to the Trust.
