

Mathematics

As mathematicians, we will continue focusing on numbers to 20 and beyond. This will include counting forwards and back, from any given number; addition and subtraction and place value; number bonds and matching subtraction facts up to 20. We will learn multiples of 2, 5 and 10. We will begin learning about measurement: length, height, weight and volume.

English

We will continue developing our English skills by reading and writing fiction, non-fiction and poetry. The children will develop different types of writing including: sequencing stories, recounts and instructions. They will use basic conjunctions such as: and, because and so to extend their sentences. Within our lessons, we will also look at adding prefixes and suffixes to words. Phonics will be studied daily and comprehension skills will be developed using our guided reading programme, 'VIPERS'.

We will continue to practise joined handwriting, use phonics and common exception words to spell as well as using simple punctuation when writing.

We encourage reading at home, (five times per week) and regular use of reading records to support the children in achieving their goals.

Science

As scientists, as part of our 'I'm Alive' topic, we will be looking at seasonal changes and ourselves. We will learn about the names of different body parts, our senses and explore are all humans the same.
