As mathematicians, we will be starting the year off by securing our knowledge of place value in numbers up to one million. We will then be continuing to focus on number, especially written methods of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will be expanding our knowledge through reasoning and investigation skills.

We will also be focusing on practicing our basic skills each week and developing our times table knowledge

As writers, we will we will be reading There's a Boy in the Girls' Bathroom by Louis Sachar. We will be writing diary entries in role as one of the characters, a persuasive letter, instructional texts, incident reports and even practicing our drama skills with playscripts. Later on in the term, we will be writing newspaper reports based on Greek myths and creating an Ancient Greek travel guide.

As readers, we will we will be looking at Thief by Mallory Blackman – a dystopian drama with a big twist at the end!

Homework Maths homework will be given out on Fridays and is due in on Wednesday. We will alternate comprehension and grammar homework each week. It will be given out on Friday and is due in on Wednesday.

As scientists, we will be studying space in the second half term. We will be looking at our solar system and the different planets within it. We will be comparing Ancient Greek views of space with those of modern scientists like Brian Cox.

As historians/geographers, we will be studying Ancient Greece. We will be looking at how life was different in Ancient Greek times, Greek gods, the Spartans and the start of the Olympics. This also links to one of our English topics – mythology. We are lucky to be taking part in the Global Scholars programme where we will join an 'e-classroom' with nine other schools from around the globe. This year's theme is 'Nature and our Cities' and we will be looking at how to improve green spaces around our local area.
