Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will:

- Talk about the things that we are grateful for
- Learn to understand and talk about our feeling and emotions

Literacy

We will:

- Explore non-fiction texts linked to sea creatures
- Read a variety of stories linked to the sea including, 'The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch' 'Commotion in the Ocean', 'The Snail and the Whale', 'Sharing a Shell' and 'The Rainbow Fish'
- Continue with daily phonics sessions following the Bug Club scheme, to develop our reading skills
- Learn to write a simple sentence

Children will be assigned two Bug Club books to read a week. These books, once read, will remain in their online library to go back to should they wish.

Physical Development

We will:

- Develop our gross motor skills doing workouts at home – yoga, Joe Wicks etc
- Develop our fine motor skills by learning to manipulate small objects including scissors
- Continue to form letters correctly, using joined up handwriting

Communication and Language

We will:

- Develop listening and attention skills by listening to, and joining in with, stories and rhymes
- Explore new vocabulary, learn to make predictions about a story, and practise retelling stories in sequence
- Learn to follow simple instructions and develop an understanding of key language
