

**As mathematicians, we will** learn about statistics, making pictograms, tables and bar graphs and reading data. We will consider place value, ordering and comparing numbers and writing them in numerals and words. We will continue to develop written methods in multiplication and division, and find fractions of numbers.

Make sure to log onto Times Table Rockstars to practise your multiplication and division facts.

**As writers, we will** develop our creative skills, using descriptive language in expanded noun phrases; adverbs to include additional interesting information and relative clauses to add extra details. We will consider comparative conjunctions and how to use paragraphs, and will use this knowledge to produce exciting explanation texts, character descriptions and story writing. **As readers, we will** look at extracts from a variety of texts and 'I'll take you to Mrs Cole' by Nigel

**As scientists, we will:** be studying Animals and nutrition in the first half term. We will look at the different types of nutrition and how these help us to maintain a healthy balanced diet. We will also look at the human body including: how skeletons and muscles provide support, protection and movement.

**As historians/geographers, we will** be considering the Romans after half-term. We will compare ancient and modern maps and learn about the Roman political system and way of life. We will consider the Roman influence on Britain and how many changes can still be seen today.
