Important Facts

An **object** is a thing that can be used. For example a door, chair, car, table are all **objects**.

Materials are what an object is made from.

Every day materials we use are: wood, plastic, glass, metal, water and rock.

Materials can be: hard, soft, stretchy, shiny, dull or rough.

Wood and metal are hard whereas fabric is soft.

The **property** of a **material** is something about it that we can measure, see or feel and helps us decide whether or not it is the best **material**.
