Year One Procedures

- Year 1/2 Entrance come straight into class when doors open at ten to 9.

Rocket Readers

- Children are expected to read with an adult <u>5 times a</u> week (reading record books are checked on a Friday).
- Please write the title of the book, date, a brief comment if you would like to and sign.



Taking books home

Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday – free choice from class corner.

They are encouraged to be independent in choosing their book from the book corner.

Wednesday– they will bring a levelled book home which is linked to their phonics level. This will only be one book. It should be re-read to develop fluency.

As well as encouraging your child to sound out and recognise high frequency words, please discuss the events and characters' feelings in the story with your child.

Reading for Pleasure

- Research has shown that children who read for pleasure have: a better understanding of texts and score higher in tests; better general knowledge; are more confident readers; have a wider vocabulary; find writing easier; and as they get older benefits their mental health.
- Children are more likely to continue to be readers in homes where books and reading are valued.
- Please read to your child and show them books are valued.



Phonics and Spellings

Phonics session 5 times a week.

The spellings that the children get each week are linked to the phonics/tricky words learnt that week.

How to help:

- Encourage sounding out and blending when reading.
- Discuss sounds found in words.
- Practise their spellings daily for their test.

How you can help your child settle into Year 1

- Encourage your child to focus on tasks for a set period of time.
- Ensure EVERYTHING your child brings in to school is named.
- Help your child to spell their surname with a capital letter.
- Practise cursive script (な よ こ d e) starting each letter
 on the line.
- Help your child to learn to read the Phase 2-5 tricky words.
- Revisit the phonics they have learned in Reception.
- Practise counting forwards and backwards to 20.
- Read to your child and help them develop a love of books.
