

Nursery: Newsletter: Summer 2: Dinosaur Roar!



This term we will enjoy becoming dinosaur experts! We will investigate fossil evidence; create our own dinosaurs; explore dinosaur landscapes and write our own class dinosaur story poem and map.

Being inspired by the subject of dinosaurs we will learn about fossilised dinosaur eggs; speculate about dinosaur families and their behaviour; consider ideas about dinosaur communication and sounds; be inspired to make some dinosaur inspired instruments and music.


We will learn about fossilised footprints and their sizes; make dinosaur feet, masks and costumes; create dinosaur dances, movements and routines for a final Dinosaur Stomp!

We will also talk about Summer activities and staying safe in the sun.

Communication and Language

(Ne will:

- Encourage the children to speak in more detail about what they have seen or heard
- Model use of different tenses and encourage children to use the correct tense in their speaking

Literacy

We will:

- Continue to practise recognising, saying and using Little Wandle revised
- Letters and Sounds
- Encourage children to give meaning to the marks they make and try to write
- some familiar letters and sounds
- Practise recognising and writing our names and other familiar letters

Maths

- Look at the shapes of objects and use mathematical language to describe them.
- Talk about patterns and create our own ABAB patterns.
- Consolidate our knowledge of numbers to 5













Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Encourage the children to develop concentration skills in large and small groups
- Practice social skills and a readiness to help each other
- Begin talking about and preparing for the transition to 'big school'

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<u>Understanding the World</u>

We will:

- Learn about different types of dinosaurs including what they ate and what happened to them.
- We will talk about how this was a long time ago in the past.
- Learn about different holiday destinations and how to stay safe in the sun.

We encourage you to share stories regularly with your children at home to help develop their imagination and storytelling skills.



We will:

- Encourage the children to remove and put on their shoes and socks for more formal PE sessions in the school hall as well as on the field. Please send them in in socks and shoes they can manage by themselves. The PE sessions will include athletics, track and using small \(\xi\$ large apparatus.
- Continue to practice using pencils, scissors and other one-handed tools with good control
- Hold a pencil correctly and use it to begin to form letters







Salt Dough Fossils

Ingredients 2 cups wheat flour cup salt 1/2 cup warm water Plastic dinosaurs Mix the flour, salt, and warm water together to make the salt dough. Roll it into balls. Press the dinosaurs into the dough. Bake at 150C degrees for

-3 hours or until hard.

Try salt dough bones too!
