As mathematicians, we will learn about geometry—describing position, direction and movement; money; place value—numbers up to 100 and beyond; telling the time to half past and O'clock and we will finish the year with addition and subtraction facts to 20 and beyond.

As writers, we will use high quality texts to help us write diary entries, stories and information. We will remember to use capital letters, full stops, exclamation marks and question marks; join ideas using and; and develop our use of using conjunctions or, but ,so and because. We will vary our sentence openers and use joined handwriting. As readers, we will be making simple inferences, learning new vocabulary and making predictions.

Homework: We strongly recommend reading at home, five times per week. Please help your child to learn their spellings.

As geographers, we will learn the countries and capitals of the UK and the continents of the world. We will look at hot and cold places. We will compare Tobermory in Scotland with Old Coulsdon.
