As mathematicians, we will be starting the half term by focusing on multiplication and division. We will be learning how to use short multiplication to multiply larger numbers by a 1 digit number and we will also be using the derived facts from our times tables to help us to divide too. Later on in the half term, we will be looking a shape and space. We will start by studying area and perimeter before moving onto coordinates in a grid.

At the end of Year 4, the children will be sitting a national times tables test, so we encourage you to practice with your child at home.

We will then move onto the Viking invasions which took place and how the Saxons and Vikings came to create a united England.
