As mathematicians, we will be beginning to learn about fractions and decimals. The term will begin with a focus on unit and non-unit fractions, finding fractions of amounts and solving addition and subtraction problems. We will then be learning about weight and capacity.

Please continue to practice times tables regularly as they help to reinforce our learning across all areas of maths.

As writers, we will be covering a variety of different genres, including discussion texts, instructions, persuasive writing and diary entries. We will be using a range of texts relating to Ancient Egypt. As readers, we will be continuing with our VIPERS sessions to improve our comprehension skills. Our text for this half term is Varjak Paw.

Please note, your child is expected to read at home a minimum of three times per week, to be signed by an adult in their Reading Record book.
