As mathematicians, we will look at the place value of decimal numbers. We will be starting to look at fractions, including finding fractions of numbers and adding/subtracting fractions. Later on in the term, we will be finding decimal and percentage equivalents. Make sure to log onto Times Table Rockstars using your usual username and password to practise your multiplication and division facts.

As writers, we will focusing on both fiction and non-fiction writing. We will be reading The London Eye Mystery. We will be writing for a range of purposes including: Diaries, Persuasive Speech, Letters, Poetry and Narratives. We will also be improving our editing skills.

As readers, we will we will be reading Cosmic by Frank Cottrell Boyce to practice our comprehension skills.

Homework will be given out on Fridays and is due in on Tuesday. The children will receive one piece of maths homework and one piece of English homework (comprehension or grammar).

As scientists, we will be studying forces and looking at how forces make things speed up or slow down and we will be investigating friction, air resistance and water resistance. We will also be looking at how we can utilise gears and pullies to make things move more easily.

As historians/geographers, we will look at a range of scientists linked to forces and look at London Landmarks based around our English book.
