Mathematics

As mathematicians, we will be focussing on multiplication and division by two digits, as well as measurement, ordering and comparing fractions and co-ordinates. We will continue to develop reasoning skills where children apply their knowledge in different ways. We will be building on our basic arithmetic skills too.

<u>Science</u>

As scientists we will be looking at the circulatory system and finding out how blood is pumped around the body. We will also focus on healthy lifestyles, discussing the impact of exercise, smoking and alcohol on the body.

Explore and Discover

As geographers, we will be introducing the topic of North America where we will be looking at the impact of extreme weather land use, economic distribution, resources and tourism.

Computing

As computer scientists, we will continue to learn how to become market analysts using a variety of different computer programs.

<u>English</u>

To develop our English skills, we will be studying Shakespeare's Macbeth (an abridged version). Through this text, we will be writing in a variety of genres including a playscript, discussion text and a monologue. We will also have a weekly focus on grammar, punctuation and spelling and will be teaching a reading comprehension weekly to develop children's reading skills.

Alongside this, we will be focussing on reading 'Street Child' by Berlie Doherty in our reading sessions which will improve the children's Vocabulary, Inference,

Prediction, Explaining, Retrieval and Summarising skills.

We encourage regular reading at home and regular use of reading records to support the children in achieving their goals.
